

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION GRANT PROGRAM

If you cannot fully meet the tuition obligation for your child(ren)'s religious education classes, you may apply for tuition assistance from the Religious Education Grant Program. Grant monies are available, but not for the entire cost of a family's tuition bill.

Families applying for a grant are obliged to the following:

- Must be a registered parish member.
- Grant application must be on file with the Religious Education Office by September 1, 2010. Applications received after September 1, will be honored only for families joining our parish after that date.
- Pay the registration fee for each child.
- A family requesting grant monies will be required to:
 1. Purchase SCRIP certificates to financially help the parish. There is not cost to the family when purchasing SCRIP. This is an easy way to help the parish. The amount of SCRIP required depends on the amount of tuition bill.

2. Volunteer their time/talent for the betterment of the Religious Education Program. There are many ways to help. The following areas can be considered:
