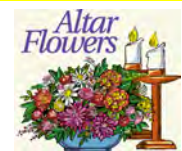

# Parish News

## **PASTOR'S CORNER by: Fr. Chris**

Here we are a week after celebrating our nation's Independence and I recall that in, August 1892, Francis Bellamy first wrote *The Pledge of Allegiance*. In today's version it reads, "I pledge allegiance to the flag of the United States of America, and to the republic for which it stands, one nation under God, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all." And does it not go great with today's readings? Considering Bellamy was a minister, I wonder if he had any of today's readings in mind when he first wrote *The Pledge of Allegiance*, "To love the Lord, your God,... and your neighbor as yourself."

It is also important to notice that the scholar, who had tested Jesus, was also affirmed by Jesus. The scholar made the statement about Loving God above all, and neighbor as self and Jesus had said "You have answered correctly." What the scholar had summarized in his statement was the natural law and the moral law. The natural law as we read in today's first reading from Deuteronomy, is written on everyone's heart and is what we call The Commandments. It does not matter where we go in the world, or in which time and place, these laws are written upon the human heart. Now whether a person listens to what has been placed upon their heart is another question. If they, the Commandments from the natural law are listened to, they are lived out in a moral life. Laws which help a person to live out, and protect a person in living out a moral life are moral laws. And if this were not enough, there are the laws which govern and oversee both of these laws, natural and moral. These are Eternal Laws, they are from God and are revealed to us. The Eternal laws not only include those laws we know through our natural ability to understand, those written on our hearts, and those we morally carry out, they are the ones which have been revealed to us by God. We continue to come to a deeper understanding of these Eternal Laws which have been revealed to us by God, in the person of Jesus Christ. This Jesus Christ, is The Person who established a Church, whose ministry is in one part to bring understanding of these Eternal Laws to the people of the world. Another part of the Church, is to see the moral dignity of each human being and bring the love of God, which is found in the Eternal Laws, to the people of the world. May our nation, under God, come to listen and understand all the Eternal Laws of God.

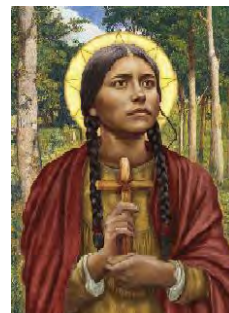

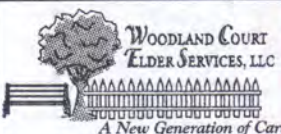
