PASTOR'S CORNER by: Fr. Chris

I don't know about you, but I enjoy the way in which the Church set up today's readings in the Lectionary. I like it especially when I look at the Gospel from Luke and then go to the first reading from Genesis. In The Gospel, we read that Jesus is praying and the disciples have asked him to teach them how to pray. And then Jesus teaches them the greatest single prayer we have, The Our Father. Yet it does not end there, Jesus continues to tell the story about the two friends and how one friend needs some loaves of bread for another friend who has come to visit him. In this story, our attention should be drawn to how the one who has come for the bread needs to be persistent in asking. Then, in the last part of the Gospel, Jesus tells the disciples that whoever knocks the door will be opened and a person will receive what has been sought after. And lastly, Jesus goes on to give some examples of what is asked for, is given, and those are good and needed gifts.

In the first reading, Abraham is speaking with the LORD. However it is not an ordinary conversation. Abraham is negotiating with the LORD over the salvation of the innocent lives in Sodom. In his bidding with the LORD, he starts out with fifty innocent lives and eventually works his way down to ten. Abraham figures he has gotten his way, surely it will be easy to find ten innocent people in a city.

Now, what I like about these stories is: In the Gospel, we have Jesus teaching his disciples, and us, how to pray. First he shows us the proper disposition we are to have in persisting in prayer. And then Jesus tells us to ask, and seek for what we need and we will receive it. It is God who knows what we need! That can be hard for us. And yet we need to be persistent and persevere. And that is what's so great about the first story, seeing Abraham negotiating with God. Yet God does not get upset with Abraham's persistence. And as we know from the story of Sodom, Abraham was growing in his understanding of the LORD and how righteous He is. God was allowing Abraham to grow in his trust and confidence in the LORD. And lastly, Abraham was growing in his humility with the LORD, the last thing spiritual leaders of the faith, say we have to overcome. And as the saying goes, that only happens fifteen minutes after we are dead. Have a great day, and keep up the prayer. And trust that God knows what we need; it is us who discover it through our prayers.

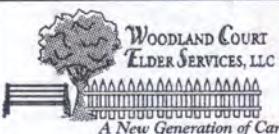
